Mrs. Fox made suggestions as to what items might be placed in the budget: copy costs, mailing costs, Insurance, District 19 meeting/training for PTA board members, State Conference costs for possibly all 4 board members and maybe few parents, office supplies, snacks for meetings. A budget committee should be developed to get this completed and presented at next member meeting. Mrs. Sharon King volunteered to be on committee.

Need for some committees and then members to be on these committees. Priority committees will be for budget & membership. Other committee discussed was for the Reflections Program. Information will be sent to each building principal about this PTA program.

Several upcoming events were discussed and Mrs. Fox shared that everyone has the opportunity to assist. Parent names will be forwarded to each school to show principals the PTA parents for their buildings. Parents who listed they would like to be Classroom Parents will be forwarded to Mr. Travaglini to perhaps be invited to the training he is planning to develop. A parent shared the Sunny D Book Spree program which is similar to the Box Top program. Grades PreK – 7th are asked to submit Sunny D labels into their teacher. Each class that brings 20 labels in can then send them in to receive 20 FREE Scholastic Books for their classroom. The program only runs to 11/30/11. Information is being sent to principals. Mrs. Hansen feels ok with going ahead with this and information/copies will be prepared for her school. Parents again were asked to volunteer to assist with collecting and helping teachers submit the labels.

A vote was taken regarding moving forward with ordering T-shirts for PTA. All in attendance were in agreement. Mr. Darryl Jackson will start looking into getting a “free” trial shirt to perhaps order with this contact.

All in attendance were in agreement of doing another Affy Tapple fundraiser in late January or early February. Confirmation needs to be made regarding doing this same fundraiser for Strassburg early October. Parents were asked to volunteer with distribution.
